

## **SCA DOES NOT SUPPORT PROPOSED TRACEABILITY REGULATORY AMENDMENTS**

The Saskatchewan Cattle Association (SCA) does not support the proposed traceability regulatory amendments. After calling for a halt on the implementation of the proposed changes and assuring producers that their voices would be heard, SCA has heard the concerns and frustrations of Saskatchewan beef cattle producers and is asking for the process of regulatory amendments to be terminated.

The Saskatchewan Cattle Association is calling for significant and immediate reform to the Canadian Food Inspection Agency to instill producer confidence and trust in our regulatory body.

The Saskatchewan Cattle Association is also immediately calling for a voting seat on the Canadian Cattle Identification Agency (CCIA) board.
